**1. CALL TO ORDER**

Chair Levenhagen called the meeting to order at 6:01pm.

**3. COMMITTEE MEETING SUMMARY**

Chair Levenhagen took roll of the Park's Board members present.

ACA Nix gave a brief report on things happening within the Park's system. The bathrooms at the Interurban Trail are being fixed, as it was discovered that these pressurized systems were out of adjustment and ruined the internal valving systems that were previously installed. These valves are being replaced, in hopes that the system will be ready for operation by the spring of 2017. The City is looking towards getting the asbestos removed from the Mortenson Farm in order to move forward with the removal of the building structure out at this facility.

Additional discussion happened in regard to the Nelson Farm and opportunities as it pertained to applying for and obtaining a future Milgard grant.

Chair Levenhagen gave a debrief of his conversation with Mayor Eiding in regard to planning for movie night for the upcoming season in the City of Edgewood. Edgewood will be sponsoring the equipment rental and is looking to purchase new equipment in 2018. The Committee discussed dates for the upcoming season, as well as movie choices and came up with the following schedule:

- ✓ May 6<sup>th</sup> – Finding Dory, City Hall
- ✓ July 21<sup>st</sup> – Star Wars, Rogue 1, Outdoor Movie
- ✓ August 11<sup>th</sup> – The Secret Life of Pets, Outdoor Movie

Anne Percival discussed planning as it related to the Community Garden. The group decided that they needed to re-evaluate the garden rules prior to the beginning of the new season and someone would locate them and bring them forward for discussion at a subsequent meeting.

A discussion commenced on finding a speaker for a pollinator garden. A date of March 27<sup>th</sup>, at 7:00 pm at City Hall was tentatively established, with additional follow-up work to be brought forward as a subsequent meeting of the Board.

Chair Levenhagen has attempted to make contact with the City of Milton in order to get an update on the placement of the Milton/Edgewood Marker, with no success.
