COUNCIL/COMMISSION BUSINESS

A. Comprehensive Plan Visioning Workshop

City Manager Bauer thanked the Council and Commission for their attendance at the Comprehensive Plan Vision Workshop, noting the importance for both the Council and Commission to be involved in the update of the City's Comprehensive Plan. He further noted the importance of the Plan to the City in all areas specifically development and growth.

City Manager Bauer introduced the City's consultant's Studio 3MW, Marcy Wagner and Debra Munkberg. Ms. Wagner led the group in introductions and a group activity. Ms. Munkberg summarized the outcome from the survey each member of the Council and Commission participated in. Based on the interviews and the City's current vision statement, the consultants identified 15 vision concepts. Each member was asked to describe their vision of the Edgewood in 20 years to help tie the concepts with the vision. The group was then asked to identify the demographic of Edgewood in 20 years. City Manager Bauer noted that due to the development of a number of multi-family properties, there will be a new dynamic to the demographics of Edgewood. The final activity involved the group each coming up with words that described Edgewood in 35 years.
