

SURVEY CONSIDERATIONS



- Not “statistically valid”
- People that participated “opted-in” (No sampling)
- May not represent all segments of the community

Conducted at low cost to the city

The survey was one component of the broader public participation approach

Could be re-used in a future survey to gauge changing attitudes against a “baseline”



Q1: DO YOU CURRENTLY LIVE IN EDGEWOOD?





Q2: HOW LONG HAVE YOU BEEN AN EDGEWOOD RESIDENT?





Q3: WHAT DO YOU ENJOY MOST ABOUT LIVING IN EDGEWOOD?





Q4: DO YOU WORK OR ATTEND SCHOOL IN EDGEWOOD?








Q6: When asked

Q9: DO YOU OWN OR OPERATE A BUSINESS IN EDGEWOOD?





Q10: HOW LONG HAVE YOU OWNED OR OPERATED A BUSINESS HERE?












Q16: DO YOU AGREE WITH THE FOLLOWING VISION STATEMENT FOR EDGEWOOD'S FUTURE?



KEY WORD OR CONCEPT – INFRASTRUCTURE

- The electricity blackouts need to be addressed.
- Sewer extensions at some point
- Sidewalks, street lighting
- Access for persons with disabilities
- I want to emphasize sidewalks specifically
- Traffic flow, internet coverage
- Too much new housing too fast. Infrastructure needs to be addressed first.
- Sewer access sooner rather than later.

- I'd love an off-leash fenced dog park!
- Quality public education and libraries
- What is your relationship with Milton and how are you collaborating with their city plan for 161 and other projects to make us feel connected in the same goals as our Milton neighbors?
- Perhaps instead of just walking, a point about transportation access generally (buses, etc.)

KEY WORD OR CONCEPT – GROWTH

- Don't go along with the expansion of the surrounding communities. Edgewood should continue to be a bedroom town, not a suburb.
- Managing growth intelligently, while preserving as much open space as possible.
- Bring in more restaurants, shopping and remove dead ones like the old Hollywood video building that is rotting. Don't overdo apartment complexes which can attract crime, more drugs and homeless population.
- Commercial building guidelines that maintain our small-town charm
- More restaurants
- Edgewood must maintain a character unique from the homogenization of the I-5 corridor.
- Stop building apartments
- Stop building multi-family residences (apartments).
- I just would like to reiterate that we love the small-town feel. We hope there won't be anymore apartments or large cookie cutter neighborhoods built as we don't have enough local businesses or roads to support them without it impacting current residents.


KEY WORD OR CONCEPT – SAFETY

- To actually have the ability for businesses to open and function in Edgewood without the planning department killing them.
- Keeping building lots to half acre or more
- The main drag on Meridian. The look and feel to be nicer, business buildings. First time I saw it, it felt gross and still does.
- To establish a more functional business corridor along Meridian with more restaurants
- Manage growth
- Stop building apartments in a community that's infrastructure can't manage

- Sidewalks for our walkers. It's not safe.
- Add a community pool


KEY WORD OR CONCEPT - TRAFFIC SAFETY

- Less traffic






Q33: WHAT RACE/ETHNICITY DO YOU IDENTIFY AS?




Q34: WHAT IS YOUR AGE?

Q35: WHAT IS YOUR ANNUAL HOUSEHOLD INCOME?


