**RE: Street Redesignation – Dom Calata Way**

On April 22, 2025, the Edgewood City Council adopted Ordinance 25-0678, officially redesignating two street segments in our city — the 10200 block of 22nd Street East and the 2200 block of 104th Avenue East — as “Dom Calata Way.”

This designation honors the memory and heroic service of Deputy Dom Calata, who was assigned to the Edgewood Police Department and was a dedicated member of our community. Deputy Calata was shot in the line of duty during a SWAT operation in Spanaway back on March 15<sup>th</sup>, 2022. He passed away the next day surrounded by friends and family, including his wife Erin and their young son Dylan.

By renaming these streets in front of City Hall in his honor, we ensure that Deputy Calata’s courage, sacrifice, and commitment to public safety will never be forgotten. His legacy will live on, not only in the lives he touched, but now in the very streets of the city he served so faithfully.

On behalf of the City of Edgewood, we extend our continued gratitude to Deputy Calata’s family, friends, and colleagues. May his memory be a guiding light for us all.
